## 3 Core Components of GxP



### Traceability

Record sufficient information to recreate processes.



### Accountability

Maintain records to identify who participated in a process.



### Data Integrity

Secure data and follow the ALCOA rule.

### ALCOA RULE

**A**ttributable | **L**egible | **C**ontemporaneously recorded | **O**riginal | **A**ccurate

## 5 P's of GxP

A useful framework to implement traceability and accountability standards is known as the "5 P's" of GxP. These refer to:



### People

Training, hygiene, reporting and review systems.

### Procedures

SOP's established, accessible and reviewed regularly.



### Products & Primary (Raw) Materials

Training, hygiene, reporting and review systems.

### Premises & Equipment

Clean facilities, monitoring, safety processes, validation and calibration.



### Processes

Overall process documented clearly, validated regularly and followed consistently.
