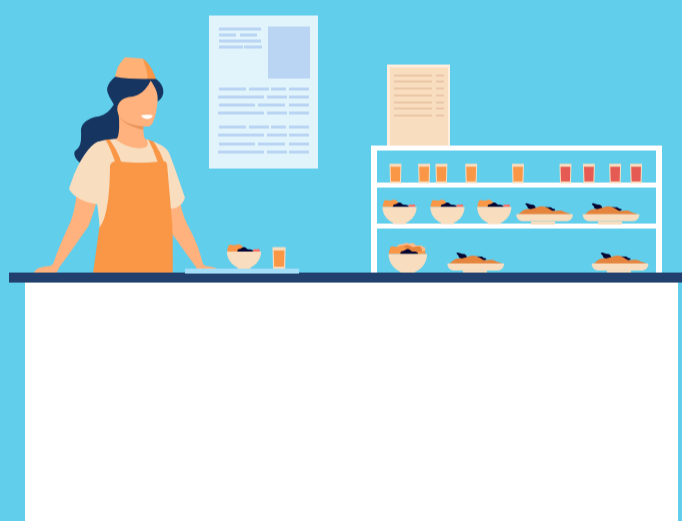


DOES YOUR EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION HAVE ENVIRONMENTAL MONITORING GAPS?



Environmental monitoring is a valuable process for protecting materials that are sensitive to conditions like temperature or humidity. For a large educational institution such as a university system, there may be multiple areas where environmental monitoring is advisable or even required by law:



FOOD SERVICE

Particularly areas where food is stored and processed, such as cafeterias.



HEALTH CENTERS

Particularly refrigerators and freezers that may store vaccines, pharmaceuticals, or blood and tissue samples.



RESEARCH LABS

Particularly any refrigerators, freezers or ovens that process or store valuable experimental materials.



SHARED FACILITIES

Cleanrooms or user facilities may have large lab spaces and many users.
